myaccount – Time Warner Cable – Business Class – signing in spinner since Dec. 2013 – SOLVED

Since they “updated” in December of 2013 I have not been able to log in to the new “fancy” <https://myaccount.timewarner.com> – I just get to stare at the spinner and the cool lookin’ Dude on the page while I sit on the phone and trial to dial in credit card information after *99 (touch tone) and whatever it is for English instead of Spanish.

I’ve tried: IE 10 and 11 on Windows PCs; Safari on iPad and Mac (Mavericks); Safari on an old iPod (iOS 6); Chrome on Mac and PC. And this is what I get – everywhere:



Figure 1 - * signing in - spins forever – checked/unchecked “Remember my username” does not matter.

I’ve sent email to my “rep” – tech support – whatever – nothing, no contact back, no information. After seven months of this mildly annoying silliness (some people call it “rank stupidity – making it impossible for your customers to pay their bills, see their bills, do anything”) I decided it is time to act! More back-story: last month if I entered the wrong password it would say so way up in the top left. BUT!, the Forgot your password link did not work. View Source...

Cheezy script stuff with botched validators and looks like good old Front Page stuff (missing the FILE:///c:/Joes Documents/login.html FP style links). The click for “Forgot your username?” has a redirector (only if validated) so I copied the redirection URL and pasted it in the address bar.

The first time trying to solve this dilemma I entered my email address at the forgotten username screen and got an email telling me that my email was my username. I already knew this, of course.

The 2nd time through (trying to recreate what eventually worked) I just clicked [Cancel] and got “The Another Time Warner Login Screen”:




Figure 2 - The Another Login Screen - [x]Remember me (or die()) - <https://login.timewarnercable.com/PasswordHelp/Commercial/login.aspx>

Put your username and password in;

AND: **CHECK the [x]Remember Me box.**

- Sorry for the caps and the bolds, but no [x]Remember Me and it all falls apart.

Click/Tap on [LOGIN]





Figure 3 - The Another Spinner - This one Eight-ish rather than iOS-ish

And, you had better:




Figure 5 - Put a CHECK in the [x]Remember my username Box



The most current statement (shown in the selection) is not actually selected, so the Download PDF link does not work.

Click (or tap) to drop the list down and then Click (or tap) on the exact same statement, then Click (or tap) on Download PDF and you get a "Open or Download" prompt (in IE11).

Statement safely clicked (or tapped) into Downloads;
